MILFORD TRACK Day Walk



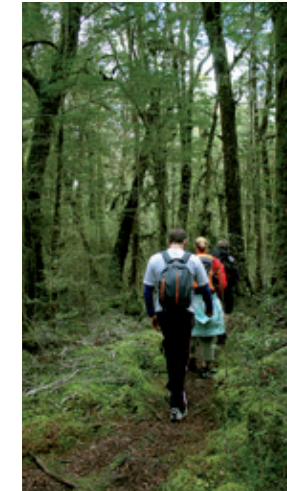
The Milford Track is renowned for dramatic alpine scenery, crystal clear rivers and ancient beech forest. Join our fully guided day walk and explore the first section of this classic track.

Accompanied by an experienced nature guide, your day begins with a coach transfer from Te Anau and a spectacular one hour lake cruise. From Glade Wharf, the track follows the Clinton River to Glade House where you'll enjoy a leisurely lunch.

The views are magnificent as you walk further up the valley through forest, grassy flats and wetlands. Along the way, your guide will point out native birds and plants, plus explain the route's fascinating history.

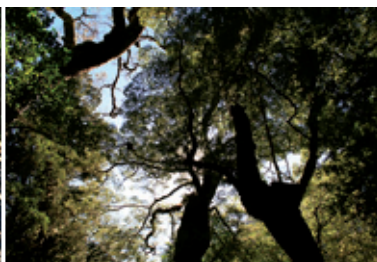
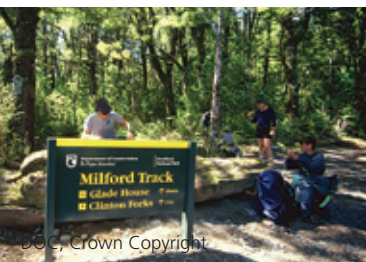
On arrival at the Neale Burn relax on the riverbank taking in the spectacular alpine views before retracing your steps.

For over a century, the four day Milford Track walk has attracted visitors from around the globe.

In 1908, Britain's Spectator magazine called it "the finest walk in the world," a reputation it has kept ever since.

Initially used by Maori as a route to obtain precious pounamu (jade), Europeans began cutting the track from Lake Te Anau to Milford Sound in the late 1800s. Awareness of the area's spectacular alpine scenery soon spread, enticing growing numbers of walkers.

Today, the Milford Track is protected within Fiordland National Park, part of the Te Waipounamu World Heritage Area.
