Stewart Island Lodge + Peaceful bed and breakfast accommodation nestled in native bush on Stewart Island. Located just five minutes walk from the village centre, the Lodge is private and secluded with commanding views across Halfmoon Bay and Foveaux Strait.

The Lodge has an extensive garden and its grounds are home to many native birds, including kaka (native parrots), which may be viewed from the terrace. In the evening, your hosts will join you in the private guest lounge for a pre-dinner drink and appetisers. Restaurants are available in the village for evening dining. Each morning we serve a full breakfast including cooked and continental options.

Accommodation + The five guest rooms with king-size double or twin beds and ensuite bathrooms, open up directly onto a large balcony.

Activities + Stewart Island is a haven for nature lovers, walkers and outdoor adventurers. Most of the Island is protected within Rakiura National Park, making it a natural refuge for native birds and plants.

The small village Oban has a general store and small museum as well as craft shops, cafes and restaurants. Activities available on the Island include: guided and independent walks, Paterson Inlet cruises, visits to Ulva Island - a wildlife sanctuary, fishing, small coach tours, sea kayaking, bird watching and exploring the stunning coastline by rental cars, motor scooters and mountain bikes.

Getting There + Located at the southern tip of New Zealand, Stewart Island is readily accessible by ferry from Bluff (1 hour) and small plane from Invercargill (20 minutes). Both options have several departures daily. Coach transfers connect with the ferries from Invercargill (all year) and Queenstown / Te Anau (Nov - Apr). On arrival at Stewart Island you will be met and transferred to the Lodge.
