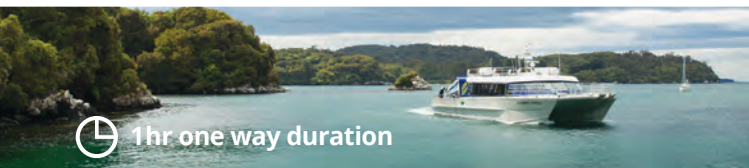


Stewart Island Ferry Services



During the one hour crossing from Bluff across the Foveaux Strait keep a lookout for wildlife, especially sea birds. Interesting landmarks commonly seen include Dog Island Lighthouse, Ruapuke Island, Titi Islands and Mt Anglem – Stewart Island’s highest point.

Coach ➔ Stewart Island to Queenstown	
3.30pm - 8pm	Nov - Apr
