Petrol

When self-driving to Milford Sound please make sure you have a full tank of petrol when leaving Te Anau (240km return).

Car parking

A car parking area is provided at Milford Sound. 20 minutes walk from the Visitor Terminal (cruise departure point). Please allow up to an hour to park and walk this distance in the busy summer months. See over for map.

Terms and Conditions: Check in 20 minutes before all departures. Cancellations and amendments: 24 hours notice (NZ time) required for refund, except for Overnight Cruises where 5 days notice is required. We reserve the right to amend timetables, cancel departures, substitute plant or equipment and alter prices at any time. Child rates (5 - 14 years), infants (0 - 4 years) travel free. Exceptions: Overnight Cruises twin-share, infants (0 - 24 months) travel free and (2 - 14 year) child rate; quad-share not available for infants (0 - 4 years).

Road to Milford

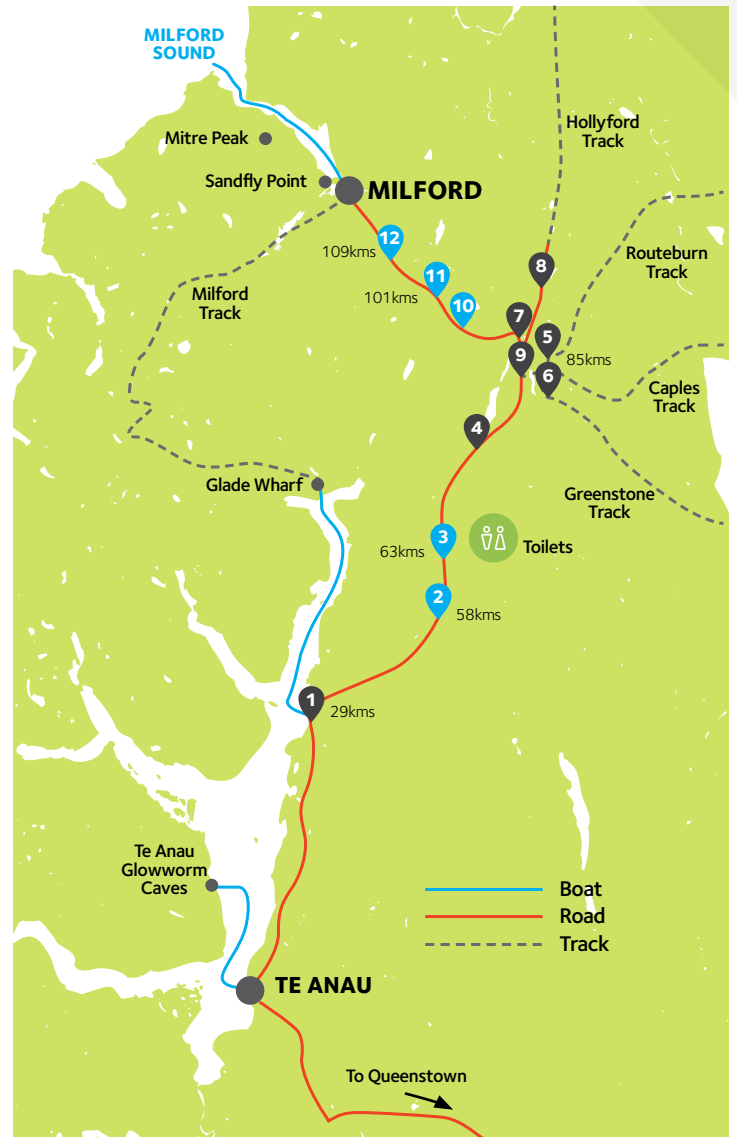
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The road to Milford Sound is spectacular and for those self-driving on a more leisurely itinerary, you may wish to experience the following stops and short walks.

- 1 Te Anau Downs**
This sheltered harbour is the departure point for Milford Track walkers.
- 2 Mirror Lakes**
Small tarns situated roadside, famous for their mountain reflections in calm weather.
- 3 Knobs Flat**
Provides visitor amenities including interpretation displays, toilets, campervan sewage disposal and telephone (card only).
- 4 Lake Gunn Nature Walk**
This loop track starts at the Cascade Creek carpark and takes you through red beech forest to the shores of Lake Gunn. On the way a variety of mosses and native birds can usually be seen (45mins return). Wheelchair accessible.
- 5 The Divide**
This is the lowest east-west pass in the Southern Alps (531m) and it marks the start of the Routeburn, Caples and Greenstone Tracks. Shelter and toilets are provided.
- 6 Key Summit**
This walk from The Divide initially follows the Routeburn Track. It takes you through native forest, then over open ground with alpine tarns, shrub land and bogs. The Key Summit viewpoint provides spectacular views of the Hollyford, Greenstone and Eglinton Valleys (3hrs return).
- 7 Lower Hollyford Road**
The Hollyford Road turn-off leads to the Lake Marion Walking Track, Gunns Camp, Humboldt Waterfall and Hollyford Track.
- 8 Gunns Camp**
Cabin accommodation and campervan sites are available at Gunns Camp. The early settlers museum is well worth a visit.
- 9 Hollyford Valley Lookout (Pops View)**
Provides spectacular roadside views over the Hollyford Valley.
- 10 Monkey Creek**
A good place to stop for the chance to see kea and the whio / blue duck, or fill your water bottle from this pristine creek.
- 11 Homer Tunnel**
This 1219m long unlined single lane road tunnel slopes down toward the Milford side with a gradient of 1 in 10.
- 12 The Chasm**
An impressive rock chasm formed by the rushing waters of the Cleddau River. The loop forest walk offers views of waterfalls and sculptured rock formations (20mins return). Please stay behind safety barriers.
